Midland Health and Midland Memorial Foundation are grateful to Celia and Word Wilson for their generous donation to establish the Celia and Word B. Wilson Family Endowment Fund. The Wilsons have been steadfast supporters of Midland Memorial Foundation since 1997, making an extraordinary impact on the Midland community with their unwavering support for healthcare and other philanthropic efforts.

Celia and Word were married in 1979 and have four children and six grandchildren. They believe the people of Midland have an entrepreneurial spirit and close sense of community, making Midland so unique. It is why they chose to raise their family here. Celia currently serves on the Midland Memorial Foundation's Board of Governors and Word serves on the Midland College Foundation Board and the Community National Bank Board. The Wilsons philanthropic commitment to improve healthcare in Midland began in the 1990s, and it is without surprise, the Celia and Word Wilson Family was selected the 2019 Philanthropic Family of the Year on National Philanthropy Day, a well-deserved honor!

In 2017, Celia and her father, Cecil Rhodes, established the Midland Memorial Foundation R. Joan Rhodes Endowment Fund in memory of her mother. Knowing the importance of having an advanced NICU in Midland, the Wilsons served as Chairs and kicked off the Level III NICU Campaign. Together with their family, Toffee and Jake McAlister and Chelsea and Blaine Sheppard, they helped raise over \$10 million!

Midland Memorial Foundation was honored with a gift of \$500,000 from Gladys Hickman to establish the Crandall Family Endowment Fund, in memory of her brother, Walter Crandall.

"Walter was born in Oklahoma City in 1933 and grew up in the Vencil Oil Camp south of OKC. He graduated from Texas A&M in 1955 and became a second-generation petroleum engineer. As a member of the A&M Corp of Cadets he had to fulfill his college ROTC obligation of two years of active duty in the U.S. Army before he could begin his engineering career. He was sent to the Aberdeen Proving Ground in Maryland and later to Fort Sill, OK where he was honorably discharged as a First Lieutenant in the Ordnance Corps. During his petroleum engineering career Walt lived and worked in most of the major U.S. oil basins from Wyoming to the North Slope of Alaska with Louisiana, Colorado, Mississippi and Texas in between. His last assignment took him to Hobbs, New Mexico. Walt retired with ARCO in 1993. He never married or had children, so he moved to Midland to be closer to his sister, Gladys Hickman and her family. He enjoyed everything Midland had to offer especially RockHounds Baseball and the ability to attend every family event. He never forgot a birthday or skipped a family holiday celebration. In 2020 Walt was diagnosed with Stage 4 lung cancer. He was treated at MMH and Allison Cancer Center and survived another 2 years. Sadly, he passed away on April 14, 2022. We, his family, are grateful for the care Walt received locally that allowed him to spend his final years with family in Midland. We created this endowment in his honor to support MMH and allow other families the opportunity to receive treatment without the need to travel."- **Gladys Hickman and family**

The Ronald McDonald Family Room offers a living room, kitchen, and laundry facilities free of charge to any family who has a hospitalized child.

"A comfortable place for families to gather close to their child while receiving medical care is irreplaceable."

Midland Health Scholarship Program

Midland Memorial Foundation is excited to announce the newly established Midland Health Scholarship Program Fund to address the pressing need for entry-to-practice certifications that serve a critical need in the hospital. Such certifications include AND, LVN, CAN, Respiratory Therapy, Radiology Technician, Phlebotomy, Pharmacy Technician and Surgical Technician.

Partnering with Midland College, Midland Health's focus is on awarding tuition assistance in exchange for a work commitment post-graduation for a term dependent on their course of study. Offering tuition assistance to financially constrained students will help secure employment at Midland Health. The development of more graduates and future Midland Health employees will facilitate outstanding care and meet the complex healthcare needs of the Midland community and surrounding areas. We are anticipating 33 in the initial year with a goal of 80% capture and in the second year, 48 participants with the same 80% capture goal. With the support of an anonymous donation of \$100,000, future students in our community will have the ability to begin their careers in the healthcare field.
