Midland Memorial Hospital and the Midland Memorial Foundation mourn the passing of Rosalind Redfern Grover, an extraordinary leader, philanthropist, and trailblazer whose life was marked by service, stewardship, and a deep commitment to her community. She was a devoted champion of Midland Memorial Hospital and a faithful steward of a family legacy dedicated to strengthening healthcare in the Permian Basin.

Rosalind’s connection to Midland Memorial Hospital spanned generations. Her late father, John Redfern, served as Chair of the Midland Memorial Foundation Board of Governors from 1977-1984, and her late husband, Arden Grover, also served as a member of the Board of Governors from 2005-2012. In honor of this shared commitment, Rosalind established the Arden and Rosalind Redfern Grover Endowment, ensuring perpetual support for Midland Memorial Hospital. Carrying forward the vision of her father and husband, Rosalind served from 2013-2020 as Chair of the Midland Memorial Foundation Board of Governors. In this role, she guided the Foundation and Hospital through continued growth and progress, and chaired multiple fundraising campaigns for Midland Memorial Hospital and remained a steadfast advocate for accessible, high-quality healthcare close to home.

Rosalind’s commitment to advancing healthcare in Midland was evident early on, beginning with the Campaign for Tomorrow, the historic capital campaign to build Midland Memorial Hospital’s replacement bed tower. Her leadership extended to healthcare expansion initiatives, including fully funding Midland’s first Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and, in 2020, co-leading the Say Yes! to Healthcare Campaign. Amid federal funding cuts and the COVID-19 pandemic, the initiative passed with 70% voter approval, establishing a ¼-cent sales tax to support the Midland County Hospital District.

A devoted alumna and Life Trustee of The Hockaday School, Rosalind served as Chair of the Development Committee and received the Hockaday Medal Award, the highest honor bestowed by the Alumnae Association. She also served on the MD Anderson Cancer Center Board of Visitors and supported numerous civic and charitable organizations. Her leadership earned her wide recognition, including the Distinguished Citizen of the Permian Basin Award, the Lifetime Achievement in Philanthropy Award from the Association of Fundraising Professionals, and the Women of Distinction Award from the Girl Scouts of America, among many others.

Midland Memorial Foundation is profoundly grateful for Rosalind Redfern Grover’s enduring contributions to Midland Health and for the family legacy she so faithfully upheld. Her leadership and vision will continue to guide our mission for years to come. She will be deeply missed and fondly remembered.

In recognition of Rosalind’s enduring influence and her lifelong commitment to the Midland community, colleagues and friends have established the Rosalind Redfern Grover Distinguished Lecture Series in her memory. Designed to advance learning and dialogue around issues that strengthen our community, the series will focus on value-based giving, promoting wellbeing, healthcare innovation, and leadership.

Doug's philanthropy reflects a multi-generational legacy of service to Midland that began with his grandmother, Ruth Scharbauer, who served as Vice Chairman for Big Gifts in 1945 - the original campaign to build Midland's first hospital.

That legacy continued through his parents, Clarence and Dorothy Scharbauer, whose leadership was instrumental in raising the funds for the Scharbauer Tower during the hospital's 2012 capital campaign. Their collective commitment helped shape the growth of Midland Memorial Hospital over decades.

Over the years, Doug has also demonstrated a deep commitment to the hospital through his service on the Board of Governors, support of the MMH Scholarship Program, the Catastrophic Fund, the Permian Basin Behavioral Health Center, and other hospital initiatives. These contributions have expanded access to care, supported patients and families in times of need, and invested in the future of healthcare across the region.

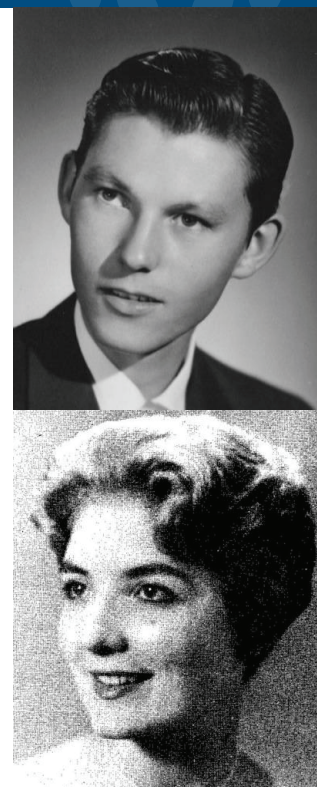
