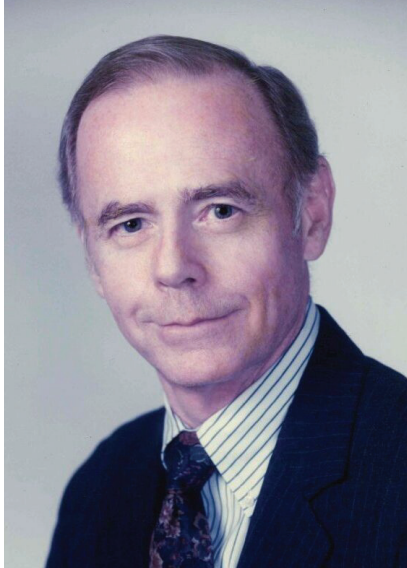

Remembering Jim Alsup

A Dedicated Servant and Supporter

Jim Alsup was elected to serve on the Midland Memorial Hospital Board of Trustees in 1987 and served as chairman of the committee in 1990. In 2010, Jim accepted the appointment to the Midland Memorial Foundation Board of Governors, where he served as chairman of both the nominating and governance committees. Jim's active involvement on the hospital and foundation boards demonstrated his dedication to continually build a stronger community.

From 1967 forward, Jim practiced law for the firm that bears his name, Lynch, Chappell & Alsup, P.C. He was a strong leader for the firm, serving as its Managing Partner and President for decades. In 2016 the shareholders of Lynch, Chappell, & Alsup, P.C. directed a \$100,000 gift to establish the Alsup Family Endowment Fund to honor Jim and his family upon his retirement in recognition of his passion for philanthropy and commitment to community service. A devoted Midlander, Jim gave tirelessly to his community through stewardship roles in numerous local organizations. He took pride in his work with the Scharbauer Foundation, where his legacy continues to shape lives. A man of faith, he served as an elder and trustee at First Presbyterian Church and embraced global mission work with quiet humility.

His legacy of leadership continues through his sons, Devin and Jeff. Jeff serves as Executive Director of the Fasken Foundation, while Devin has continued his father's professional journey at Lynch, Chappell & Alsup, P.C. and demonstrated his commitment to the hospital through his service on the Board of Trustees.

Midland Memorial Foundation Awards Over \$42,000 in Nursing Scholarships

- 1- Radiology



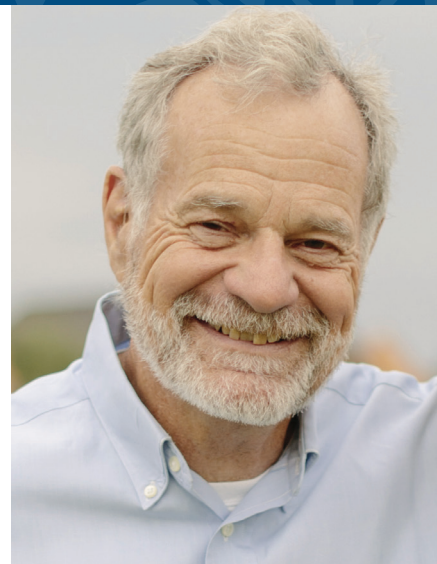
