Frank Kell Cahoon

Statesman and Friend

On January 30, 2013, Midland Memorial Hospital and the entire community of Midland, Texas, lost a dear friend and one of its greatest supporters with the death of Frank Kell Cahoon.

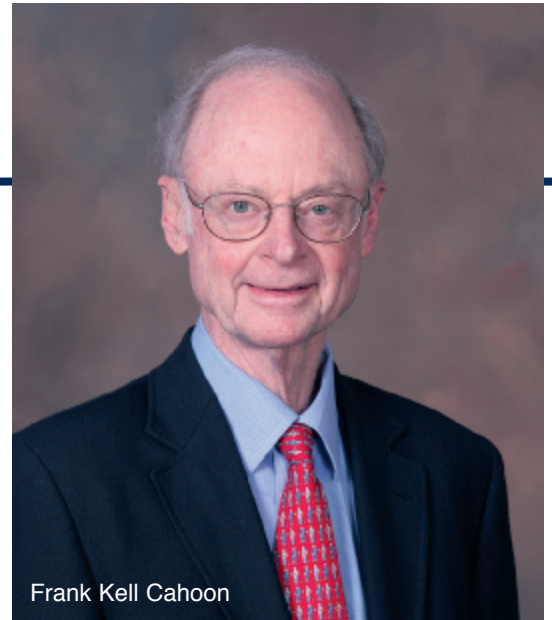
Frank was born to Charles Wilbur Cahoon, Jr. and Sibyl Frances Kell Cahoon on June 20, 1934, in Austin, Texas, and was raised in Wichita Falls. He graduated from Wichita Falls High School and spent his freshman year of college at the Colorado School of Mines in Golden, Colorado.

The following summer, he met the love of his life, Paula Powers, and followed her to the University of Texas at Austin. The two were married in 1957, then moved to Killeen, Texas, where Frank was stationed at Fort Hood as a first lieutenant in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

In 1959, Frank and Paula moved to Midland so Frank could pursue a career in the oil business. In 1964, Frank was elected to the Texas House of Representatives as the only Republican to serve in the 1965 Texas legislative session. The family resided in Austin while Frank served two terms.

In 1969, the family returned to Midland and Frank settled into the oil industry. Successful in the energy business, Frank played a prominent role in the construction of the Kenai Oil Refinery, one of Alaska's first refineries.

Frank was very active in the Midland community. He was a member of the Midland City Council

and served on the boards of many local nonprofit organizations. Frank served on the Midland Memorial Board of Trustees from 1989 through 2006, when he joined the Board of Governors.

Throughout his 23 years of service to Midland Memorial, Frank had the best interest of Midland Memorial Foundation in mind. He would often call with a suggestion or a tidbit of information that he thought would benefit the Foundation. Frank's devotion and unfailing commitment to the betterment of Midland Memorial Hospital will always be remembered.

Paula and Frank were married for 56 years and have three children – Corrinne, Frank, Jr., and Joseph. Frank is preceded in death by his parents and beloved grandson, Charles Hayden Bowers. They have seven grandchildren and numerous extended family and friends. All who knew Frank will miss his tall tales, warmth, and humor. Midland, and the state of Texas, is blessed to have had Frank Kell Cahoon among its citizens.

A Source of Help for Those in Need

Many of the patients who come to Midland Memorial Hospital for treatment drive from surrounding communities under unexpected circumstances.

Recently, MMH received a report about an out-of-town patient whose car had a serious breakdown, leaving her with no transportation and no money. A member of the MMH Auxiliary saw the need and worked to get the patient's vehicle repaired and to find her a place to stay until the car was fixed. Other volunteers and staff members heard about his efforts, and helped cover all costs of the repair and lodging.

The difference made by the remarkable kindness of MMH volunteers and staff members shed light on the acute needs sometimes experienced by families in unforeseen situations. As a result, an anonymous

donor established the Chaplain's Discretionary Fund to provide an organized means for providing immediate financial assistance to Midland Memorial Hospital patients, family members, and visitors who may experience an urgent need.

The Chaplaincy Department at Midland Memorial Hospital verifies eligibility for assistance and administers the funds as needs are presented.

"Over the years, I have been deeply touched by the caring spirit of the Midland Memorial family," Chaplain David Harwood says. "The Chaplain's Discretionary Fund was inspired by the kindness and compassion demonstrated by members of the Volunteer Auxiliary."

A Named Endowment Perpetuates the Legacy of a True Friend

Midland Memorial Foundation is pleased to announce the establishment of the Billy Ray “Pee Wee” Watson Endowment Fund.

According to his family, Bill Watson, also known to friends as “Pee Wee,” was a man who could be counted on to lend a hand whenever he saw a need.

By establishing the Billy Ray “Pee Wee” Watson Endowment Fund, Bill’s family hopes to build upon his legacy by providing resources to maintain the valet service provided at the Craddick Medical Office Building on the Midland Memorial Hospital campus.

Bill Watson was born August 29, 1928, in Snyder, Texas. He was a veteran of World War I and graduated from Sul Ross University where he met his beloved wife, Delores. Together, Bill and Delores have three children – Barry, Brad, and Bambi, along with nine grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. Bill was preceded in death by his granddaughter Haley Harvey.

Bill began working in the oil field at age 14. In 1963, he started 3B Oil Company and Watson Packer. Over time, he started, purchased, or expanded more than 10 additional companies and is credited for inventing

sand shields, grabber packers, and spot control valves. Bill once said, “I never set out to invent anything, I just set out to do a job. But sometimes it happened there was no tool to get the job done and we had to come up with one.”

Bill’s inventive imagination also gave way to a full life outside of the office. His family recalls Bill’s insistence that he always had time for family and friends. Whether he was at the lake, hunting, or just playing around with family, Bill made a lasting impression on all those who knew him.

He is a husband, father, grandfather, and friend who will be deeply missed.
