Clarence Scharbauer, Jr.

A Legendary Philanthropist

On February 21, 2014, Midland Memorial Foundation was saddened to learn of the death of Clarence Scharbauer, Jr., a dear friend of MMH for over a half-century. So much has been written about Clarence in recent months. He has been called a legend, a patriarch, a philanthropist, a builder, a horseman, and a businessman. The story of Clarence's life rivals the romantic tales of old; full of challenges, victories, deep rooted love, and devastating loss.

Clarence Scharbauer, Jr. was born in Midland, Texas, to Clarence Scharbauer, Sr. and Ruth Cowden Scharbauer in 1925. Clarence once remarked that he was raised on a horse and toughened up by seasoned ranch hands. At the young age of 17, Clarence left the ranch to attend Texas A&M University. Upon the death of his father, Clarence returned home to care for his family's estate. He later served four years in the United States Navy, and returned to Midland in 1946 to assume control of his family's ranching operation, which he continued throughout his life.

After his return home, Clarence married his wife, Dorothy Turner Scharbauer. Together

they raised four children, Clarence Scharbauer III, Douglas Scharbauer, Chris Scharbauer, and Pamela Scharbauer.

At the young age of 22, with his mother, Ruth, Clarence co-chaired the Major Gifts campaign of the newly formed Midland Memorial Foundation. MMF had been created for the purpose of building a communityowned hospital for the citizens of Midland. In 1946, Clarence gave \$50,000 to the original effort of the campaign and succeeded in raising \$1.25 million to build Midland's first hospital. For the rest of his life, Clarence provided philanthropic and leadership support to Midland Memorial Foundation as he served on the Board of Governors since 1964. At the time of his death, he was serving as a Governor Emeritus, a lifetime honorary appointment.

His most astounding gesture of support came in 2008 when Clarence launched the Campaign for Tomorrow with a \$25 million donation. With his incredibly generous donation, Clarence stirred the resolve of other philanthropists in the community and helped MMF raise almost \$68 million to build the Scharbauer Tower at Midland Memorial Hospital. Along with ownership, the following is expected from ALL employees at MMH:

- Walk MMH guests; don't point
- Prompt call response
- Quiet at night
- Purposeful hourly rounding
- Bedside handoff
- Communication boards
- Leadership rounding

Executive staff and directors, across the organization, participate in rounds on patients throughout the hospital at the beginning of each month. This is a time for patients to have one-on-one time with the leaders of MMH and address their personal patient care to make sure MMH is reaching our patient care expectations.

First Graduation Held for New Residency Program



On May 23, 2014, MMH had 28 residents graduate from our Nurse Residency Program. The new Midland Memorial Hospital Residency Program consists of 25 percent classroom instruction and 75 percent hands-on training. Training takes place at Midland College's state-of-the-art simulations lab as well as at the bedside. The program features courses led by subject-matter experts on current and emerging clinical guidelines and standards.

Clinical preceptors provide personalized bedside training, as well as mentoring with personal support, career development guidance, and debriefing sessions. The process creates a forum for exchange among residents. The Nurse Residency Program at MMH is an 18 to 22 week orientation process within all inpatient units. Nurse residents attend the nursing school of their choice,

and upon graduation, residents are committed to a one-year working contract with MMH.

Along with the new Residency Program, Midland Memorial Hospital has introduced a Nurse Intern Residency Program (NIRP) available to all nursing students. Through the NIRP, the students gain vital skills and knowledge to enhance their journey through nursing school. Better-equipped bedside nurses with practical experience and hands-on precepting and training are the end result. Successful nursing residency programs ultimately benefit patient care at MMH.

Your Estate Plan Check-In

10 Essential Topics to Consider

No matter your age or health, it's important to have your will and other estate plans in order. If it's been a while since you reviewed your plans—or if you haven't created a will yet—use this checklist to take stock of your situation.

- ☐ An up-to-date will. Have you recorded your plans for the future? If so, is your will current? You'll need to update this document after major life changes, such as births, deaths, or a move to a different state, or if tax law changes occur.
- □ Update your beneficiary designations on life insurance and retirement plans.

 To change beneficiaries of your life insurance or retirement plans, contact your insurance company or the administrator of the retirement plan for a change-of-beneficiary form. Then return the form to your insurance company or plan administrator.
- ☐ A healthcare power of attorney and a durable power of attorney. Have you named a trusted person to make health and financial decisions for you if you are no longer able to make those decisions yourself? Communicate the details about how you would like those decisions carried out.

- ☐ Add a living will. A living will (not to be confused with a "last will and testament") permits you to make known to your loved ones and caregivers your decision on life-prolonging procedures *before* a problem arises.
- ☐ Location of your important documents.

 You don't have to reveal what's in these documents (wills, trusts, insurance policies, etc.), but it's a good idea to make sure someone, like an attorney or friend, knows where they are and how to access them.
- ☐ Property including jewelry, art, and other collectibles. One easy way to keep track of your property is to create an inventory list on the computer. Or, you can make a videotape inventory.
- ☐ Charitable giving through your estate.

 If you include a charitable organization like

 Midland Memorial Foundation in your
 plans, you can keep your assets for life
 while helping MMF provide beneficial
 services to others thereafter.
- ☐ Key advisors, such as attorneys, financial consultants, accountants, and insurance specialists. Your unique situation will determine the number and type of advisors you need. In any case, they should counsel you about the best ways to protect your assets. Let your loved ones know who your trusted advisors are.
- ☐ Final wishes or funeral arrangements. It's a good idea to communicate your wishes to your family. Being aware of this information now will make a sorrowful time when you pass away less stressful for loved ones.


