# Barbara J. O'Shaughnessy

# **A Woman of Grace and Giving**

A longtime friend of Midland Memorial Foundation, Barbara J. O'Shaughnessy, died on September 20, 2014, at the age of 92. Barbara was born July 5, 1922, in Austin, Minnesota, and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1944. She married Donald E. O'Shaughnessy in 1946, and moved to Midland, Texas, in 1950.

Barbara and her family have a long history with Midland Memorial Hospital. Five of her six children were born at MMH. In 1956, Barbara's husband, Donald E. O'Shaughnessy, was elected to the Board of Trustees for a term from 1956 through 1960. In 1981, Don joined the Board of Governors where he served until his death in late 1995. Barbara joined the MMH Board of Governors in 1999 and joined the distinguished Governors Emeriti in 2010. She was faithfully committed to her leadership role at Midland Memorial Foundation.

#### Decades of Philanthropy

In 1956, Barbara and Don began their philanthropic history with MMH by

helping to purchase the very latest in radiology equipment. Through the years, they have provided gifts for nursing scholarships as well as financial assistance for cancer patients. Barbara contributed to the building efforts of the Craddick Medical Office Building, and most recently, contributed to the establishment of the Scharbauer Tower project. Not only did Barbara and Don give personal monetary gifts, they also assisted in securing contributions from the I.A. O'Shaughnessy Foundation for MMH's first magnetic resonance imaging equipment (MRI), MMF's Endowment Fund, the Craddick Medical Office Building, and the Scharbauer Tower.

In 2009, Barbara's children and the I.A. O'Shaughnessy Foundation also made possible the Barbara J. O'Shaughnessy Garden at MMH. The garden, located adjacent to The Market at MMH, was dedicated to Barbara in the summer of 2010 with several generations of her family members and many of her friends looking on proudly.

In 2010, the O'Shaughnessy children established the Barbara J. O'Shaughnessy

On July 23, 2014, Midland Memorial Foundation was saddened to hear of the death of Agnes Elizabeth Anguish, known to all as Aggie. She was born November 10, 1928 in New Braunfels, Texas, to Karl and Thekla Amelung and raised in San Antonio.

## The 3 Most Important Documents You Can Own

**Make Sure Your Plans Protect Your Loved Ones** 

#### 1. A Will

At your death, a will serves as a road map telling your executor how to distribute your assets to other people or to charitable organizations. Without a will, you are powerless as to how your assets will be distributed. By creating a will, you can dictate the following:

- An executor. You choose this key individual who oversees the process of settling your estate.
- Beneficiaries. You can determine which family members or loved ones will receive the assets in your estate. Don't forget to include the charitable organizations you care about, such as Midland Memorial Foundation.

#### 2. Durable Power of Attorney

A durable power of attorney allows someone to conduct financial matters on your behalf while you are living, such as signing documents, purchasing or selling assets, or making bank transactions. This document remains in effect even if you become incapacitated or disabled. The power ends, however, at your death.

#### 3. Healthcare Power of Attorney

Because the typical power of attorney relates to financial decisions, a recommended companion document is the healthcare power of attorney, or healthcare proxy. This allows you to appoint someone to make medical decisions on your behalf should you become unable to do so. If you wish, you can designate different people to handle financial and medical decisions.

A healthcare power of attorney may also encompass or be accompanied by a living will, directing that no extraordinary life-sustaining medical procedures shall be used to prolong life when it is medically determined that no hope of recovery remains.

#### Breast Cancer Doesn't Just Happen in October

The comprehensive breast team was shocked to learn only 28 percent of Midland County women, over the age of 40, have mammograms. This statistic revealed an alarming low number when compared to the State of Texas mammography rate of 50 percent and national average of 60 percent. After learning this important information, the team quickly reacted and created an even more active, comprehensive outreach program for the community.

To help increase the awareness of the importance of mammography, MMH employees eligible to have a mammogram, accepted the challenge to get their annual mammograms by the end of October 2014. This internal community campaign not only heightened awareness, it also saved lives. Three employees were diagnosed with breast cancer when they participated in the "Pink Out" initiative. Fortunately, the cancers were discovered in the earliest curable stages and their outcomes are most favorable.

The comprehensive breast team is committed to making sure all women who meet screening guidelines in Midland County have access to the mammography center. Barriers such as fear, lack of time, or financial situation should not deter the patient from having a mammogram. Wanting the best for Midland County, the goal of the comprehensive breast team is to increase the average number of women having mammograms.

Midland Memorial Hospital's Allison Women's Imaging is a Certified Quality Breast Center of Excellence, **one of only four** in the State of Texas and the only one in the Permian Basin. The comprehensive breast team is made up of radiologists, surgeons, pathologists, and oncologists; a multidisciplinary team designed to care for patients close to home.
