

The Dorothy Turner Scharbauer and Clarence Scharbauer Jr. Tower

Setting a Precedent in West Texas Healthcare

As we celebrate the fifth anniversary of the Scharbauer Tower opening its doors, we reflect on the community support that provided, and continues to provide, a foundation to catapult MMH into a new era of healthcare.

In 2006, Hospital administrators confirmed the need to build all new inpatient facilities due to the original infrastructure being over 60 years old and presenting daunting challenges in healthcare delivery. The task of assembling the capital resources to execute this bold, new vision emerged, and at \$175 million, it is the largest capital project in the history of the hospital. In 2008, Midland Memorial Foundation accepted the challenge to raise \$60 million of the total project cost.

In April of that year, Midland Memorial Foundation's Campaign for Tomorrow kicked off with a historical \$25 million pledge made by Clarence Scharbauer, Jr. It is the largest contribution ever received by Midland Memorial Foundation, and it set the tone for the remainder of the campaign. With over 700 donors, the Campaign for Tomorrow surpassed the original goal and raised more than \$66 million to support the building project. Midland Memorial Hospital completed the

project under budget and opened the doors to the Scharbauer Tower on December 19, 2012.

Today, the Scharbauer Tower continues to exceed expectations by providing a state-of-the-art facility as a basis for MMH healthcare providers to deliver best-practice care and continually improve patient experiences. As MMH looks to the future to meet the challenges and needs of the diverse population of the Midland community and surrounding areas, MMF is confident in the support of our donors. Time and time again, the Midland community proves their commitment to having quality healthcare available locally.
