Midland Health and Midland Memorial Foundation are grateful to the FMH Foundation for their generous donation of \$1 Million to establish the Dr. Eileen Piwetz Nursing Scholarship Endowment Fund. Their generosity will provide nursing scholarships for employees and community members who want to pursue a career in nursing for generations to come.

Dr. Piwetz is an alumna of Texas Women's University, the University of Texas of the Permian Basin, and Nova University. She was the Dean of the Health Sciences and Director of the Associate Degree Nursing Program at Midland College. Dr. Piwetz then served as the Vice President of Institutional Advancement at Midland College and Executive Director of the Midland College Foundation, Inc. During her time at MC, she collaborated with Midland Memorial Foundation in developing an estate planning seminar that continues to provide quality education for local professionals for over two decades.

In 2011, F. Marie Hall established the FMH Foundation and selected Dr. Piwetz as the first Executive Director where she steadily honored Marie's commitment to improve our community. Through the years, FMH Foundation with Eileen's dedication and knowledge of healthcare, has grants funding vital programs and capital projects awarded Midland Memorial Foundation with several grants funding vital programs and capital projects at



Midland Memorial Hospital. These include grants to build out the 9th floor of Scharbauer patient tower, the renovation of the F. Marie Hall Outpatient Center, support for the Emergency Department, Breast Center and NICU as well as the spirit-lifting "Look Good Feel Good Shop" for cancer patients.

In retirement, Dr. Piwetz will serve as a board member of the FMH Foundation and continue to inspire. She has a passion for philanthropy and has been a mentor to many. Her wisdom and dedication have impacted the lives of many people and made Midland a better community.

Their stewardship has also contributed to several projects at Midland Memorial Hospital including the Craddick Medical Office Building, the Scharbauer Tower and the Level III NICU Campaign.

Recently the Woodcock's expressed their gratitude for Midland Memorial Hospital and staff for the good service and care offered to our community. Their family chose to honor their grandson, Hunter Holloway, by donating in his memory to Midland Memorial Foundation. They lost Hunter to post Covid-19 Psychosis in the prime of his life, at the age of 25 and on the cusp of graduating college. Hunter lived a life filled with love and joy. His many interests ranged from his cowboy days at the family ranch, his frenetic enthusiasm for his favorite teams, playing sports and sharing his musical talents. His impersonation of Elvis was amazing!

"In his life, Hunter had to combat many health issues including Tourette's syndrome, asthma and depression. Mental Health being one of the most serious and growing concerns in our world, we are confident that our hospital,

as the backbone of our medical community, will continue to address this issue with all the resources available to them. Hunter, we love you so much." Claire and Jim Woodcock

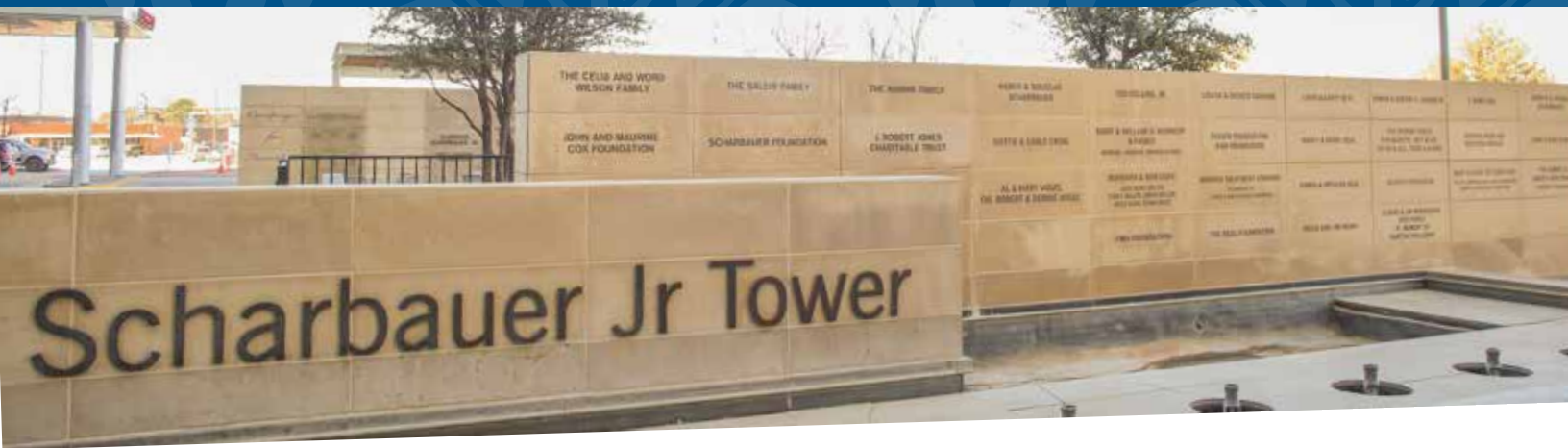


The COVID-19 pandemic has had a profound impact on the mental health of people of all ages, families and entire communities. According to a study by public health researchers at Brown University and Boston University, the percentage of adults in the United States experiencing elevated depressive symptoms has quadrupled in 2021 from 8.5% before the pandemic to 32.8% in 2021. Due to the link between the pandemic and its impact on mental health and the need for additional resources in the Permian Basin, the state of Texas awarded \$40M to Midland and Ector County Hospital Districts for a Behavioral Health Center to benefit our region. Plans for the new Permian Basin Behavioral Health Center are currently underway with an expected completion in 2024.

On behalf of Midland Memorial Foundation and the Board of Governors, we would like to thank the Claire and Jim Woodcock Family for their generous donation given in loving memory of Hunter Holloway. We are grateful to them for sharing Hunter's story and addressing the ongoing burden of the pandemic on Mental Health.
