In retirement, Dr. Piwetz will serve as a board member of the FMH Foundation and continue to inspire. She has a passion for philanthropy and has been a mentor to many. Her wisdom and dedication have impacted the lives of many people and made Midland a better community.

Claire and Jim Woodcock donate \$750,000 in memory of their grandson, Hunter Holloway, completing their \$1,000,000 commitment toward capital gifts


Claire and Jim Woodcock have been valued members of the Midland community since 1980. They have had much success in business and life. In return, they have generously given back to the Midland community by giving their time, talent and gifts to many organizations, focusing on Education and Health. Claire and Jim serve on the Board of Governors for Bynum School, and Jim is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Petroleum Museum, and the Development Board of the University of Texas of the Permian Basin. Their stewardship has also contributed to several projects at Midland Memorial Hospital including the Craddick Medical Office Building, the Scharbauer Tower and the Level III NICU Campaign.

Recently the Woodcock's expressed their gratitude for Midland Memorial Hospital and staff for the good service and care offered to our community. Their family chose to honor their grandson, Hunter Holloway, by donating in his memory to Midland Memorial Foundation. They lost Hunter to post Covid-19 Psychosis in the prime of his life, at the age of 25 and on the cusp of graduating college. Hunter lived a life filled with love and joy. His many interests ranged from his cowboy days at the family ranch, his frenetic enthusiasm for his favorite teams, playing sports and sharing his musical talents. His impersonation of Elvis was amazing!

"In his life, Hunter had to combat many health issues including Tourette's syndrome, asthma and depression. Mental Health being one of the most serious and growing concerns in our world, we are confident that our hospital,

as the backbone of our medical community, will continue to address this issue with all the resources available to them. Hunter, we love you so much." Claire and Jim Woodcock

The COVID-19 pandemic has had a profound impact on the mental health of people of all ages, families and entire communities. According to a study by public health researchers



at Brown University and Boston University, the percentage of adults in the United States experiencing elevated depressive symptoms has quadrupled in 2021 from 8.5% before the pandemic to 32.8% in 2021. Due to the link between the pandemic and its impact on mental health and the need for additional resources in the Permian Basin, the state of Texas awarded \$40M to Midland and Ector County Hospital Districts for a Behavioral Health Center to benefit our region. Plans for the new Permian Basin Behavioral Health Center are currently underway with an expected completion in 2024.

On behalf of Midland Memorial Foundation and the Board of Governors, we would like to thank the Claire and Jim Woodcock Family for their generous donation given in loving memory of Hunter Holloway. We are grateful to them for sharing Hunter's story and addressing the ongoing burden of the pandemic on Mental Health.
