

What will happen to the data in the current systems once MMH transitions to Beacon?

 When MMH goes live on Cerner historical patient information will be available in a new electronic legacy data archive system, Trinisys ClearView. ClearView will provide a consolidated view of patient data from a number of our legacy systems including: CareVue Athenahealth Allscripts A4 GE RIS ORSOS GE CPN (Perinatal) MediLinks Respiratory Therapy and Inpatient Rehab GE Muse Mediware HCLL Blood Bank ICNET 	 ClearView provides direct access to a consolidated view of all historical patient information sourced from a variety of clinical systems easily accessible from the patient's chart in Cerner including: Patient demographics Problems Allergies Medications Immunizations Encounters Lab results Progress Notes, Face Sheets, Discharge Summaries, images and other patient documents
Clearview provides the ability to automate information request workflows with advanced search and document bundling capabilities across multiple legacy data sources increasing productivity, streamlining workflows and optimizing resources. The Trinisys ClearView implementation project is underway and in the Requirements Definition phase. IT is working with Midland HIS Analysts and operational SMEs to define the requirements and necessary customizations to archive MMH's legacy clinical systems. This phase also includes defining end user workflows that facilitate operational processes that require utilizing Cerner and the legacy data archive system.	 Trinisys ClearView Timeline Updates System development and testing will occur in March and April with End User Training following in May For most staff, an online 30-minute training course will be sufficient to learn how to use the new legacy data archive system HIM and other advanced users will receive a 60-minute more indepth training to learn additional search and reporting capabilities necessary to support their job functions The rollout of ClearView will occur in conjunction with the Cerner go-live and include go-live support.
