A minimum donation of \$50 or more will qualify you for the Be a Light Giving Program, as well as 150 BetterU points in 2025. Starting in 2026, the minimum donation to be included on the Be a Light annual recognition plaque is \$130 annually or \$5 per pay period. You will receive 8 hours of PTO for a donation of *one hour of pay per pay period **after one year of giving is completed.**

A \$1,000 contribution or \$38.46 per pay period for a year (paid by June 1, 2026) will include recognition for the Campaign for Tomorrow. All Midland Memorial Foundation giving is cumulative and will qualify for the standard recognitions. Donations are tax-deductible within the limits of the law.
